
# Sunshine Report

# Cook's Corner...

**Apple Cider Syrup** 

Ingredients:

½ cup sugar

4 teaspoons cornstarch

½ teaspoon ground cinnamon

1 cup apple cider or 1 cup apple juice

1 tablespoon lemon juice

2 tablespoons butter

# **Directions:**

In a small saucepan stir together the sugar, cornstarch and cinnamon.

Then stir in the apple cider or juice and lemon juice.

Cook and stir mixture over medium heat till mixture is thickened and bubbly, then cook for two minutes more.

Remove from heat and stir in butter till melted.

Makes about 1½ cups.

Serve over Apple Cinnamon Pancakes or Waffles.


